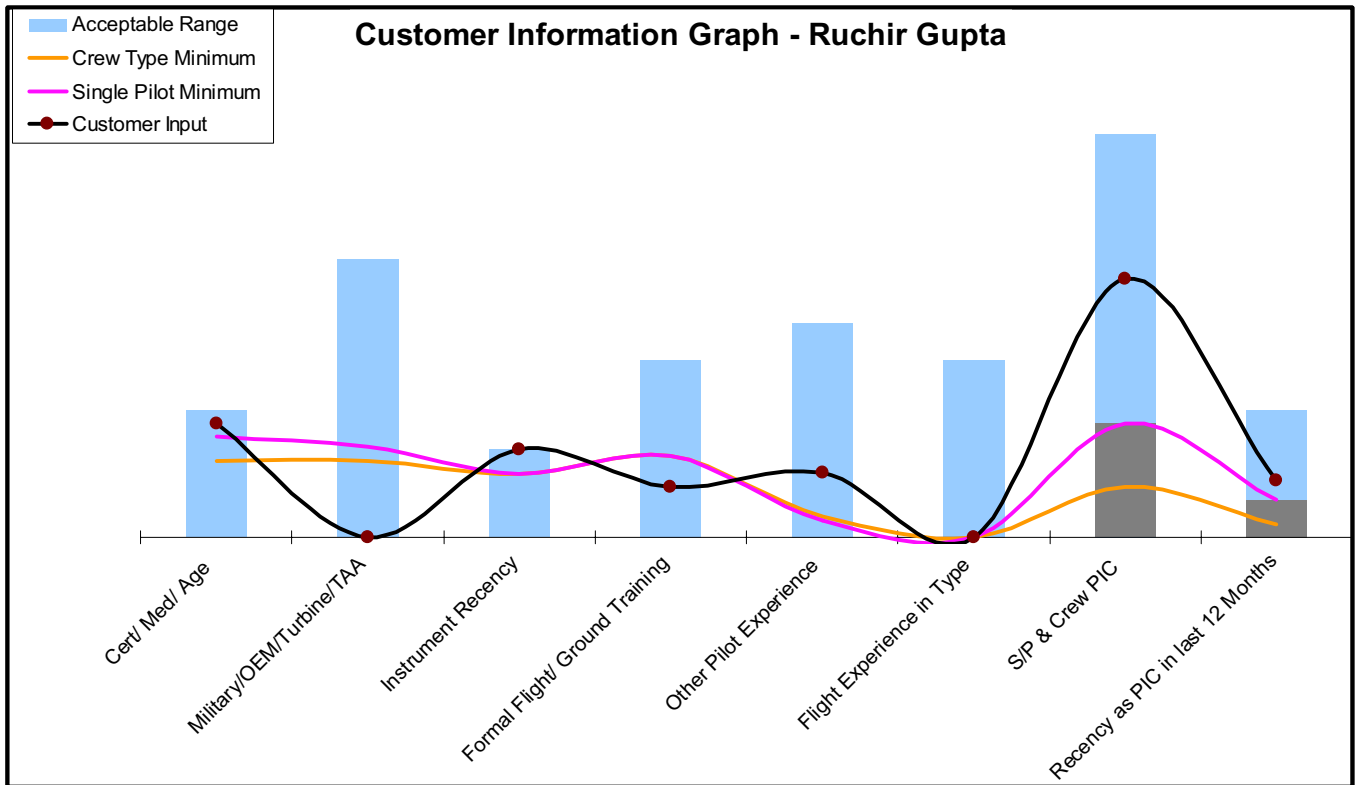


## Proficiency Index™ Results

The Customer Information Graph below displays your Proficiency Index (PI) results based on the information you provided on the Customer Information Form (Page 2). From this graph, you can easily see how your information compares to the baselines created for crew and single-pilot curriculums. Please see pages 7-9 for an explanation of these various PI categories.



These results indicate you are eligible for the **Second-in-Command Curriculum**.

Holding a Second-in-Command (SIC) qualification allows you to perform pilot-flying and pilot-not-flying duties in the Citation Mustang with an appropriately rated pilot acting as Pilot-in-Command (PIC). Once you obtain subsequent experience in the Mustang, you may resubmit your pilot experience for the PI to determine your eligibility to earn your Crew Type-Rating as a PIC. After gaining experience as a Captain, you may then graduate to the single-pilot curriculum.

*Note: An appropriately trained SIC may apply to the FAA for a CE-510 SIC type rating with proof of having made one takeoff & landing in the actual airplane.*
